Worldviews, Time and Astronomy



HOW DOES A WORLDVIEW affect the interpretation of scientific observations about the universe? At our January meeting, the contrasting worldviews of biblical creationism and naturalism will be compared and matched against reality, by popular author and speaker Dr. Don Chittick*.

Questions discussed will include the following examples:

How accurate is astronomical time?

Where in the universe are we?

Are space and time absolute?

Do celestial motions fit better with heliocentrism (the sun is the center of the solar system) or do they fit better with geocentrism (the Earth is the center of the entire universe)?

How does Scripture relate to heliocentrism and geocentrism?

Answers and observations relating to these questions will be offered by Dr. Chittick, in what promises to be a thought-provoking session.

THIS MONTH'S DSA MEETING WILL BE HELD on Saturday, January 15, 2011, from 9 to 11:30AM, at Rolling Hills Community Church. *Be sure to attend this meeting for some unique and intriguing observations relating to time, worldviews and origins!*

*Donald E. Chittick holds a Ph. D. in Physical chemistry from Oregon State University, and has taught at the University of Puget Sound and George Fox College. A contributor to several books and periodicals, he has lectured on the creation / evolution topic throughout the past two decades, both in the United States and abroad. As an inventor, he holds several U.S. and foreign patents and is active in the area of alternative fuels.

For more than thirty years, the Lord has granted Don and Donna Chittick the privilege of serving Him in the area of showing the total accuracy of the Holy Bible. Their ministry has centered around Bible and science questions, especially those related to the first eleven chapters of the book of Genesis.
