

Camouflage in Nature Requires a Designer



FOR THIS JUNE MEETING, Rick Thompson will share a Power-Point presentation of photographs and quotes, on the subject of camouflage in nature. He will propose that camouflage is not necessarily a survival technique and could not have simply evolved over millions of years. With hundreds of examples of camouflage and mimicry, Rick will demonstrate the wide variety and types of animal deception, ask thought-provoking questions about its purpose and show how it exhibits design which *requires a designer*.
